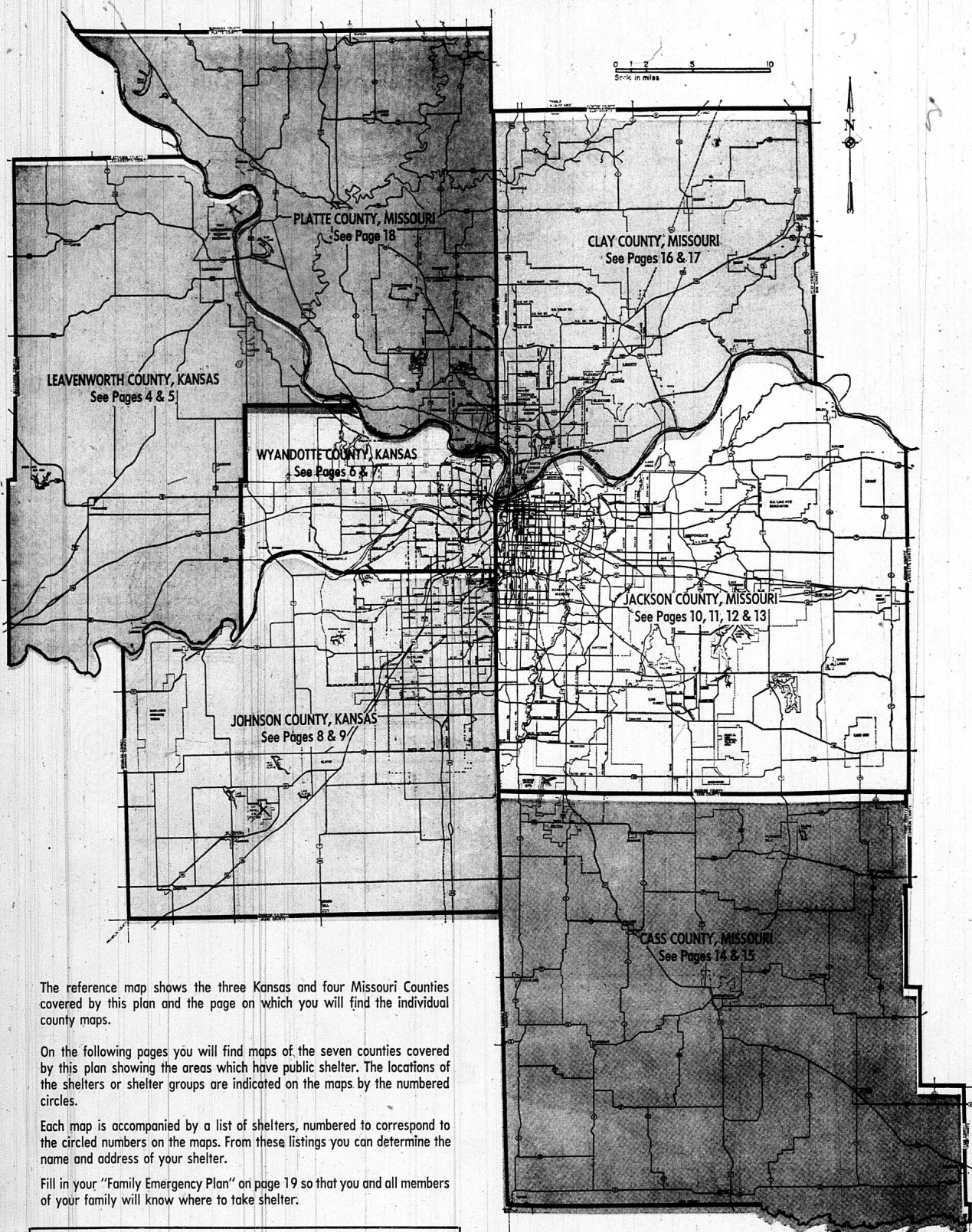


7-COUNTY KANSAS CITY AREA

The reference map shows the three Kansas and four Missouri Counties covered by this plan and the page on which you will find the individual county maps.

On the following pages you will find maps of the seven counties covered by this plan showing the areas which have public shelter. The locations of the shelters or shelter groups are indicated on the maps by the numbered circles.

Each map is accompanied by a list of shelters, numbered to correspond to the circled numbers on the maps. From these listings you can determine the name and address of your shelter.

Fill in your "Family Emergency Plan" on page 19 so that you and all members of your family will know where to take shelter.

IF YOU ARE TO GO TO PUBLIC SHELTER, GET THERE PROMPTLY

Should you receive warning to go to shelter, follow your Family Emergency Plan and take shelter immediately. A trained shelter manager will be in charge in most public shelters. You should co-operate with this official representative of the city government.

Most public shelters contain survival supplies of food and water. Study the information on page 19 to determine if there are additional supplies you wish to take to the shelter.
