

HOW TO USE THIS PLAN

Find your normal daytime and nighttime locations on the maps. These are the places where you work and where you live. If you are located in an area shown in color (either solid or striped) there is a public shelter for you. If you are in an area shown by a solid color, you should walk to shelter. You should drive to your shelter only if you are in an area marked by colored stripes.

Each map is accompanied by a list of shelters, numbered to correspond to the circled numbers on the maps. From these listings you can determine the name and address of your shelter and fill in your Family Emergency Plan on page 19.

If you are located in an area shown in white, there is no public shelter available at this time and you must seek the best shelter available. Methods of improvising shelter at home and on the farm are described on pages 19 and 20 of this brochure.
